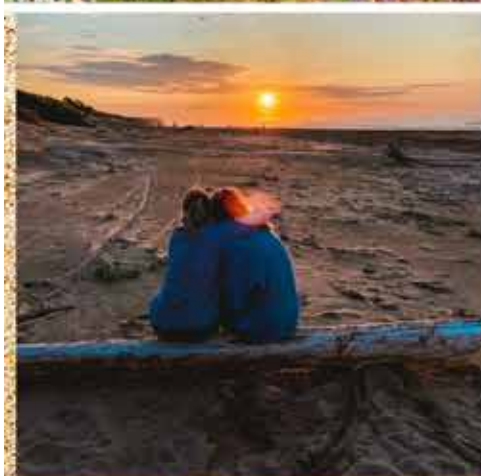

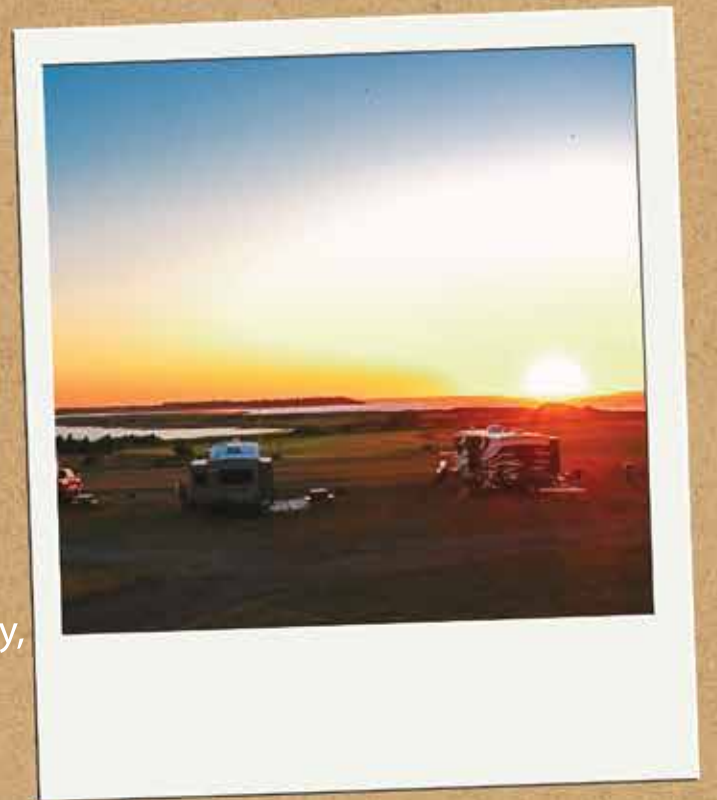

Policies & Information

Parents, please inform your children of park rules as we should never have to confront a child. Violators may be evicted without refund.

QUIET TIME

11:00PM - 8:00AM | Please respect your neighbours, excessive noise is not allowed at any time. Sound carrying beyond your site during quiet time may result in future camping privileges being revoked.

CHILDREN

No child is to be left unattended at Twin Shores. Children are to be kept under careful watch at all times by a responsible adult. Guests under 19 must be back on their sites by 10:00PM unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

VISITORS

Visitors must register and pay applicable fees. All visitors must leave by 10:00PM. Individuals without vehicles entering the park are considered visitors regardless of age. The site holder is responsible for the actions of their visitor. We reserve the right to refuse admittance to Twin Shores. NOTE: unregistered visitors found on your site is a violation & may result in eviction without refund.

CONDUCT

We have a zero tolerance policy for disorderly, abusive or indecent conduct. Any person engaging in activities that are illegal or could be harmful to others will be evicted immediately and authorities will be called. If you observe any questionable behavior, report it to park personnel immediately. After hours security - (902) 960-7433 or campground office - (902) 836-4142.

ALCOHOL

Consumption of alcohol is discouraged at Twin Shores. Consumption must be done on your own site and in concealed containers.

PETS

Must be on a leash and attended to. Pets are not allowed in any park building or playground. Pets must be cleaned up after. Hostile or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Exotic pets not permitted.

SMOKING

Cannabis consumption is permitted only inside one's RV. All common areas are smoke free.

TREES

Our trees are precious. Do not cut limbs, climb or attach anything to our trees.

VEHICLES

Speed limit is 10KMH. Slow down for kids' sake. Use of power wheels, go-peds, scooters or any off-highway vehicle is not permitted. Golf carts not permitted unless rented from Twin Shores.

GENERATORS

Not permitted.

DRONES

For the privacy and safety of our guests, drones are not permitted.

CLAM DIGGING

Dig for clams right here at Twin Shores on the Basin Beach! Remember, no more than 100 clams and the size can't be smaller than 2 inches.

BEACH SHUTTLE

Why walk when you can ride? Call 960-RIDE (7433) | 11am - 5pm on beach days.

Please allow up to 15 minutes for the shuttle to arrive.

VEHICLE PASS

Place hang tag on rearview after entry scan. On morning of departure deposit hang tag in designated drop boxes by checkout time. \$20 charge for lost, stolen or damaged hang tags. NOTE: permitting a non-registered person access to Twin Shores with your pass will result in camping privileges being revoked.

BICYCLES

As per PEI law, helmets are required regardless of age. No riding after dark or through campsites.

TRESPASSING

Bordering land owners will press charges.

FIREWORKS & CHINESE LANTERNS

Illegal on PEI. No incendiary device may be lit on park grounds or on our beaches.

GARBAGE

We do not collect garbage at campsites. Garbage must be sorted following Waste Watch guidelines and taken to dumpsters or the recycling centre. Do not leave garbage outside. Absolutely no mattresses.

WATER

Please conserve our limited supply. No vehicle or RV washing.

SEWER

Must use a "doughnut". Only septic friendly, biodegradable holding tank treatments permitted.

ELECTRICITY

AC must be off when absent from the RV for over 30 minutes. Please do not charge Electric Vehicles on campsite. EV charging stations available by park entrance.

CAMPFIRES

Fires must be attended to at all times, under control & extinguished by 12AM.

LOST & FOUND

The central lost and found is located at the security office. Additional lost and founds for clothing are found in each laundromat.

RECREATIONAL STRIPED BASS FISHING

FROM

Twin Shores Beaches

KNOW THE RULES

- Fish must be between 50 & 65cm in order to be legally kept
- There is no license required to recreationally fish striped bass
- Season for PEI bass fishing in tidal waters runs from April 15 - Oct 31
- Fishing is allowed 2 hours before sunrise until 2 hours after sunset
- Fishers can use only barbless hooks
- Fishers are permitted to catch 3 striped bass per day
- Fishers cannot have more than 3 fish in their possession at any time, incl. in a fridge/freezer

the meaning of the mast

Have you ever wondered why we have a big mast (flagpole) flying a South African flag? It's an incredible story that begins with an amazing woman named Kirsten Neuschafer whom we met in January of 2021.

Kirsten sailed her ship, the Minnehaha, from Newfoundland to Summerside, arriving January 6th, where she was to meet Darren, one of Twin Shores' owners. Darren's workshop was to be home base for Minnehaha's refit. It was during the moving of Minnehaha from the Summerside harbour to the shop that she met Eddie Arsenault, who was organizing the move. That meeting proved to be incredibly beneficial to Kirsten as she and Eddie worked side by side for 10 months until Minnehaha was ready to leave PEI.

While on the island, she quickly became like family. After replacing Minnehaha's original wooden mast with a stronger, taller aluminum mast, she gifted the original to Darren & Twin Shores, which is the one you see at the park today. We fly the South African flag here (where Kirsten is from), and she flies our Twin Shores flag on her ship. Kirsten was offered so much help from so many Islanders, she now calls PEI her "other" home.

So what was all this for? On September 4, 2022, Kirsten embarked on the the Golden Globe Race - a solo, non-stop sail around the world, via the five Great Capes with no modern sailing technology. She was unable to return to land without being disqualified. She was 1 of 16 sailors in the race, and the only woman. On April 27th, 2023, after more than 235 days at sea, she won the race and arrived triumphant in Les Sables-d'Olonne, where many supporters, including Darren & Eddie were waiting to greet her and celebrate. She was one of only 3 sailors to finish the race. We are so proud of Kirsten's accomplishment & honoured to have played a small part in her journey!

So what's the story on this place?

In the fall of 1890, Dr. Jack arrived in Kensington. He had landed in the port of Charlottetown on a steamer from London and had arranged to spend the winter with a local business man in Kensington.

The next spring, Dr. Jack hired a crew to start construction of his new home. He was lonely for the old world charms of London, instructing builders to recreate a Tudor style manor. When completed it housed the doctor's practice and a well needed Inn for the town.

Before long, visitors were coming from all over the Maritimes and the New England states to stay at Whitechapel, Dr. Jack's mansion. It was rumored that he could cure all sorts of ailments; people begged to be involved in his experiments, residing in the inn and enjoying the splendor of his gardens.

His guests were mostly travelers coming for a short stay and gone again. It wasn't until the disappearance of his assistant, Dr. Eugene Splicer, sometime between 1929 and 1930, that people first became suspicious as to what was really going on inside the walls of Whitechapel. This unexplained disappearance prompted an investigation by Kensington's finest.

The findings of the investigation were inconclusive. Kensington Town Police felt that perhaps Dr. Splicer had moved on to greener pastures as visitation to the Dr.'s Inn had slowed with the tough economic times of what would become the Great Depression.

A bit of a pioneer in the area of health, Dr. Jack may have been responsible for the first blood bank in Atlantic Canada. During the years of the second world war he opened his doors promoting blood donation and collection.

Dr. Jack was seen less around town, keeping to himself, always buried in his work. Although we can't be certain of his age, by this time he should have been getting to be an old man, but reports suggest that he aged very well.

Visitations to the inn slowed over the years and following a devastating ice storm in 1956, the inn finally closed after losing power for a prolonged period and being badly damaged. It is unclear what ever happened to Dr. Jack. He vanished from record sometime later and the property changed hands and underwent several renovations over the years.

A number of attempts to reopen the Inn under new management failed. Often due to a series of unexplained 'accidents', others claimed the place was haunted by the patients of Dr. Jack or Dr. Jack himself!

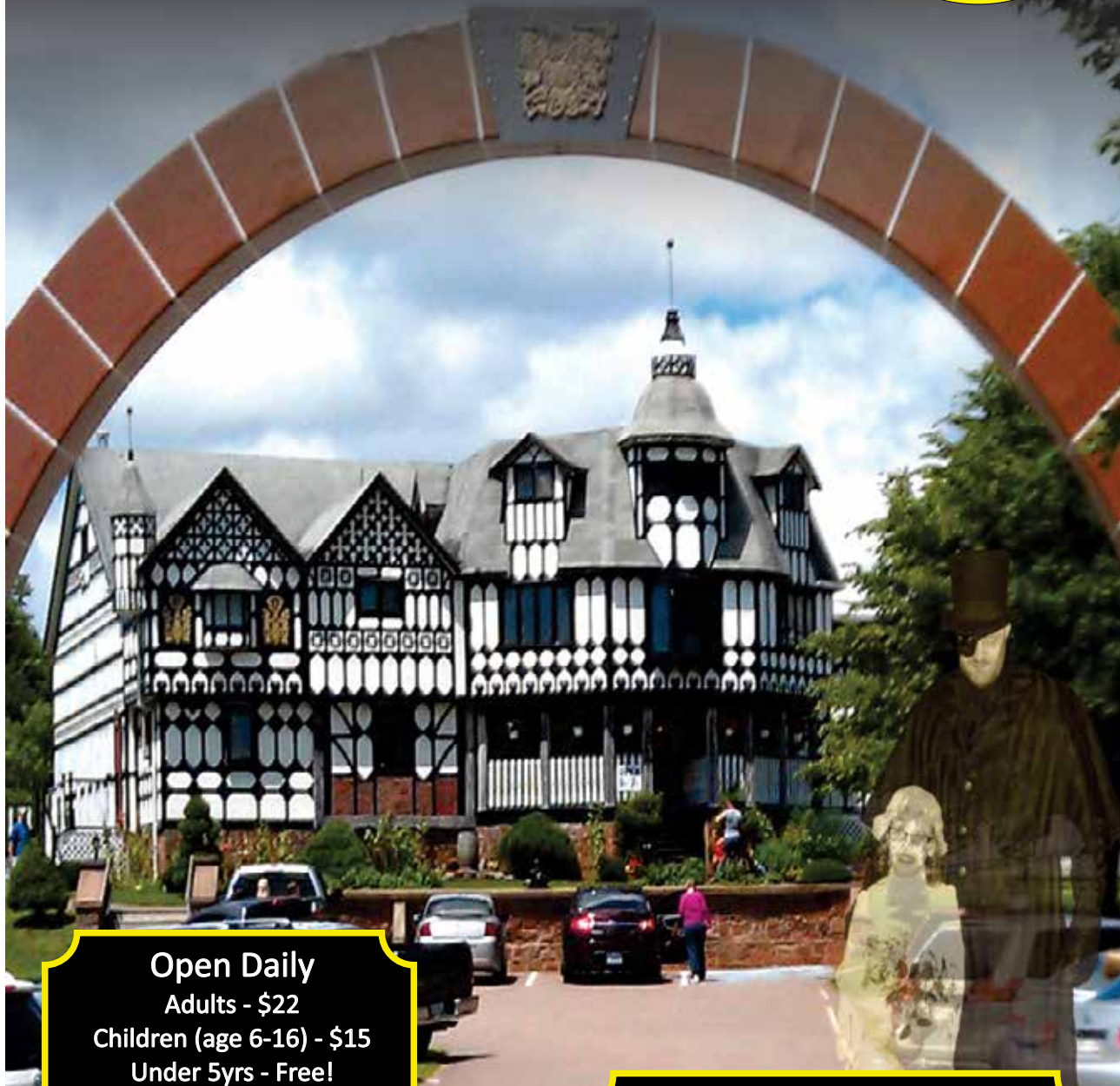
The current owners have decided not to hide the murky history any longer. In the latest attempt to revive the old building, owners have tried to capitalize on Dr. Jack's mystery. In 2001, 110 years after Dr. Jack began construction on the building, the first annual Halloween - Nights of Fear was held and Islanders flocked to the Mansion again after all those years. In 2005, during a renovation, workers uncovered some of Dr. Jack's own surgical tools, some disturbing notes containing arcane symbols, and assorted bones. There was too much information now to ignore the truth.

In June of 2006 the Haunted Mansion opened to the public in its full glory. There have been more discoveries and unexplained occurrences that need to be shared, to be revealed to all! Take a walk through yourself and make up your own mind, but don't call us in the middle of the night if you can't sleep. Phone a friend, call an ex.

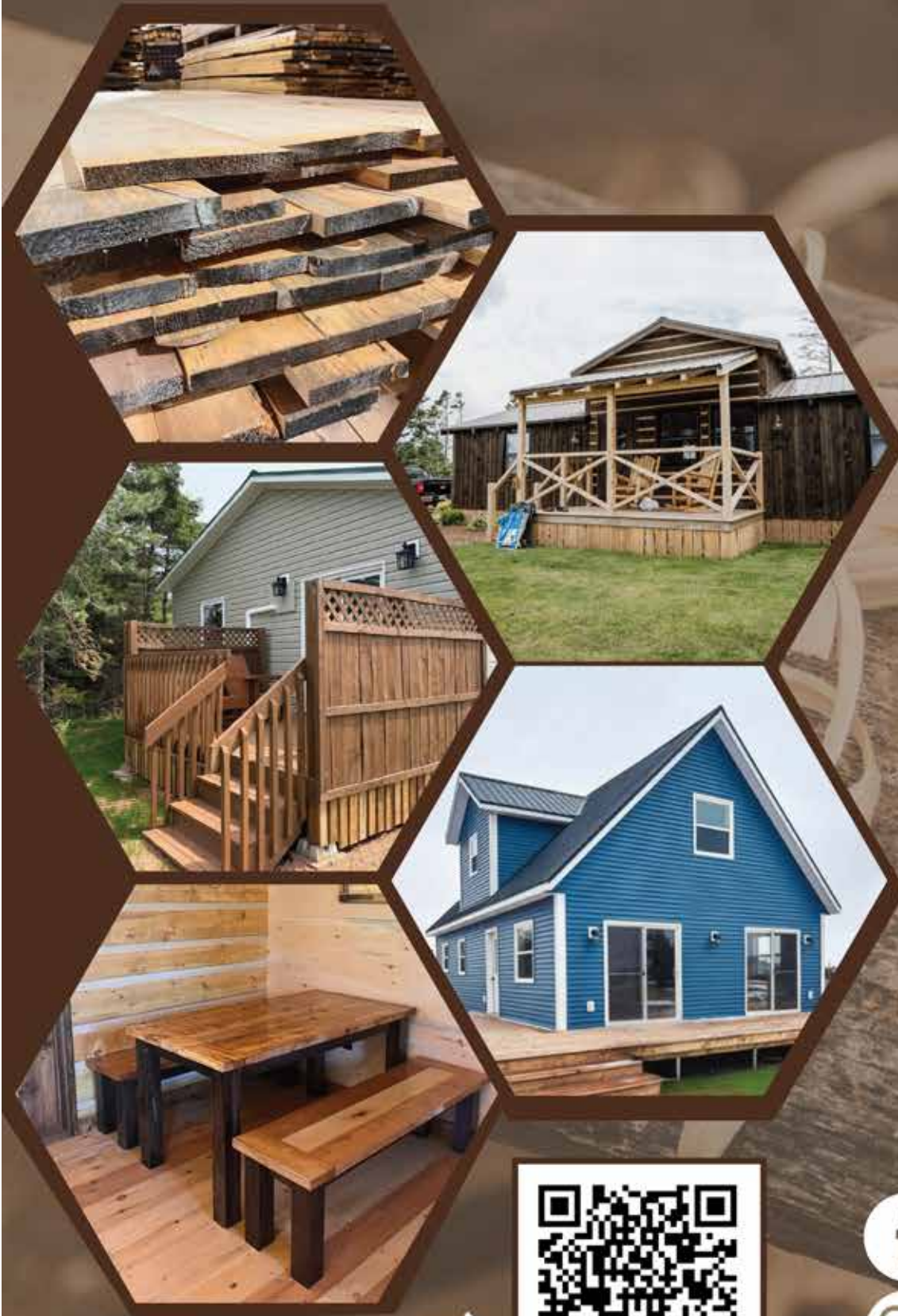
